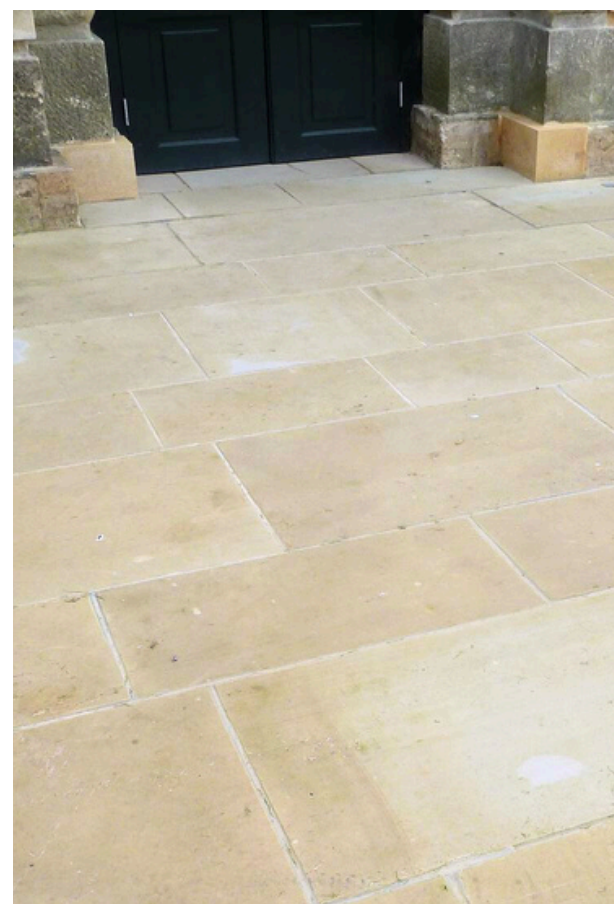


BLenheim PALACE
