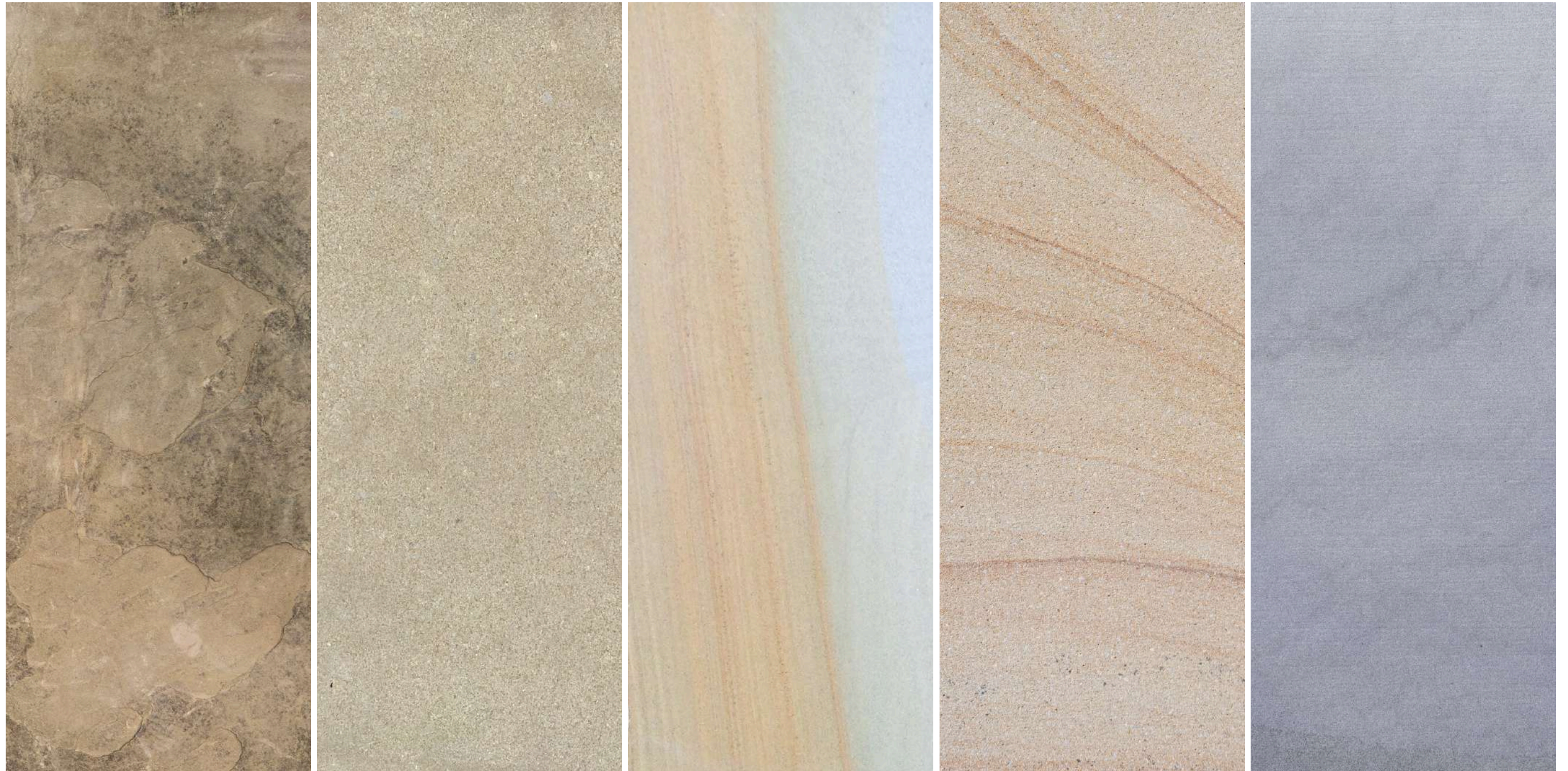

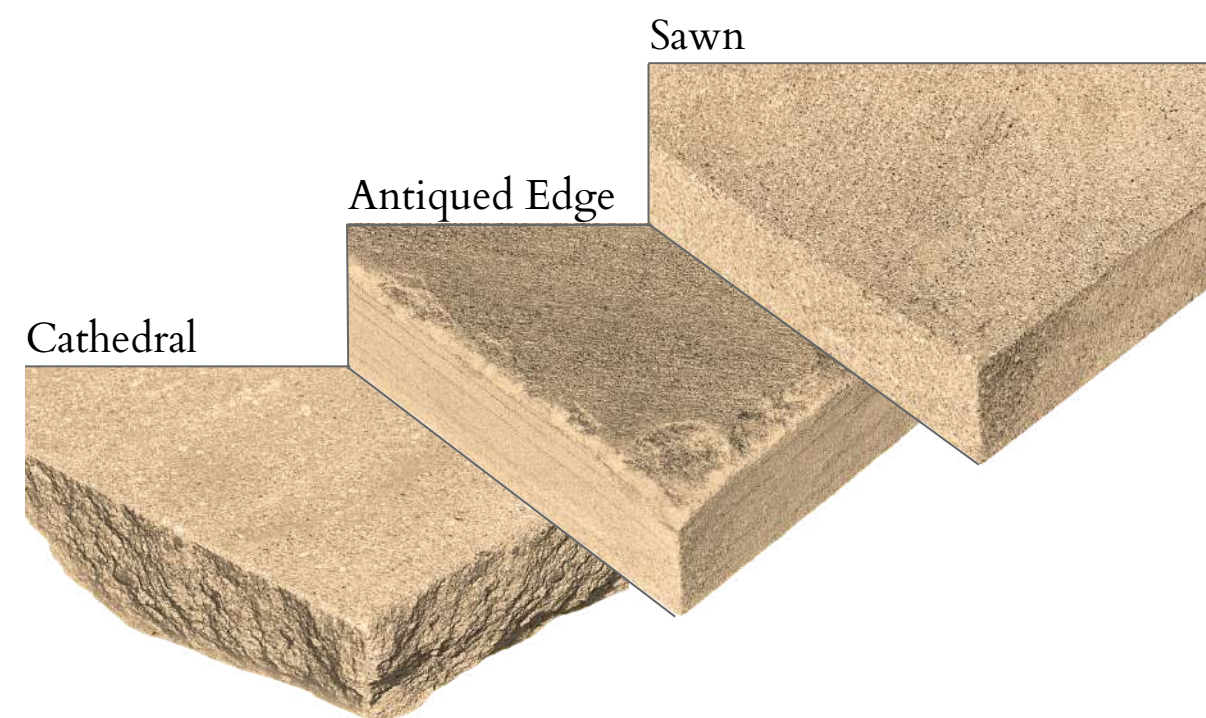

ABBEYSTEAD

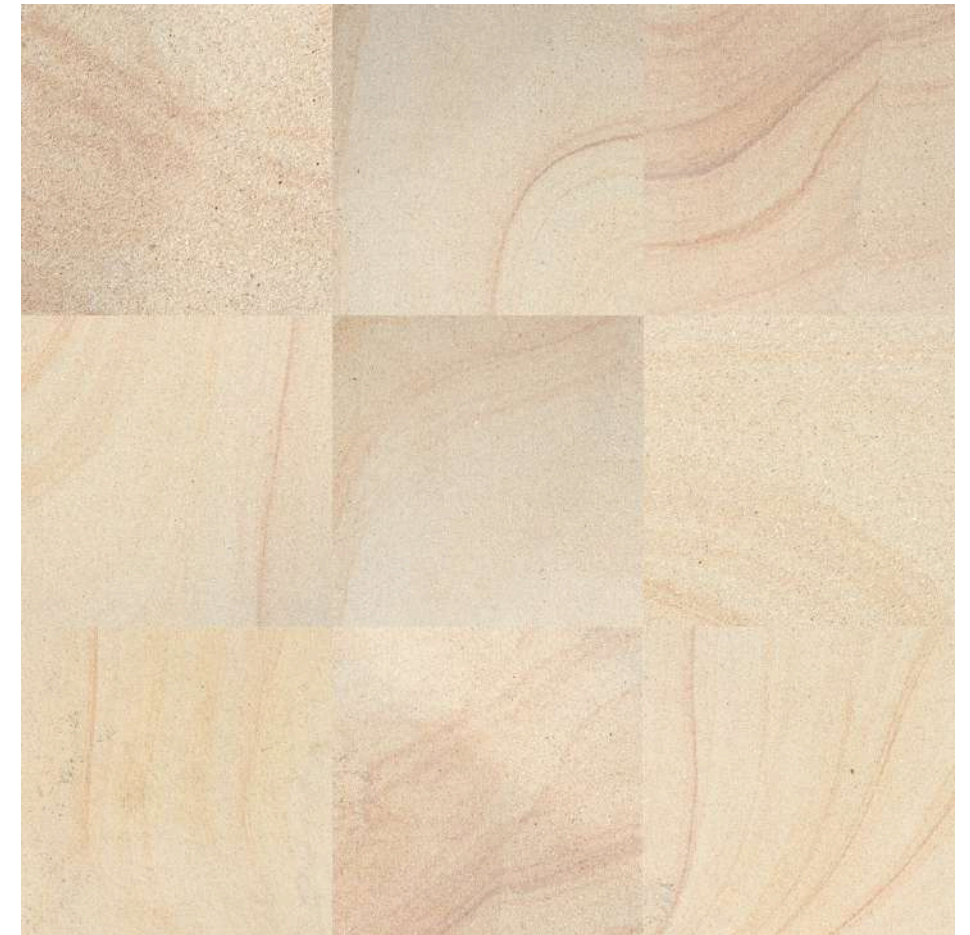
